RE: Rule 40 – Foul Weather Gear, Winter Parka, Climbing Boots, Work Gloves, Safety Shoes & Safety Gloves

Dear Mr. Sanchez:

In reference to your request to amend the aforementioned rule of the Controlling Agreement, the Carrier proposes to amend Rule 40 as follows:

Current Language:

Rule 40 – Foul Weather Gear, Winter Parka, Climbing Boots, Work Gloves, Safety Shoes & Safety Gloves

(b) A winter parka will be supplied by the Company at two-year intervals at no cost to each employee covered by this Agreement who, as part of his/her regular assignment, is required to perform service outdoors. The care and maintenance of the parka shall be the responsibility of the employee.


Proposed Language:

Rule 40 – Foul Weather Gear, Winter Parka, Climbing Boots, Work Gloves, Safety Shoes & Safety Gloves

(b) A winter parka will be supplied by the Company at two-year intervals at no cost to each employee covered by this Agreement who, as part of his/her regular assignment, is required to perform service outdoors. In lieu of the parka, the employee may order an "Ike jacket." The care and maintenance of the parka/Ike jacket shall be the responsibility of the employee.
